



Tips for Law Enforcement



- Law enforcement should recognize signs of mental health crises.
- Some jurisdictions have CIT policies that outline screening criteria for people experiencing a mental health crisis.
- While state laws vary, non-judicial custody for the purpose of a mental evaluation may be a necessary option for the safety of the person and those around them.

Assessment Information to Consider



Verbal Indicators

 What the person is saying and how they are saying things

Behavioral Indicators

- Observation of abnormal behavior
- Body language

Environmental Indicators

 Observation about the person's environment that may indicate mental illness
